At the beginning of the lock down in Massachusetts, people were panicked and had no masks. The Chinese community in Weston where I live quickly formed a donation group – WeStar Alliance. We soon collected over 100,000 dollars. With the help of Doctor Wu, we were able to purchase masks, googles and face shields. I also donated money to help people using 3D printer to print face shields. We then delivered the medical supplies to hospitals in Boston and the Weston Fire department as well as Weston Nursing homes.
